ALL STAR COMICS #8

DC's Big Three were blessed with auspicious beginnings. All Star Comics #8 did for Wonder Woman what Action #1 and Detective #27 did for Superman and Batman. America's Guardian Angel was an instant hit who served as a graphic representation of the women's war effort during WWII, predating Rosie the Riveter by two years. The upside potential of this issue cannot be stressed enough. Wonder Woman's overdue solo film received critical acclaim and birthed a whole new aeneration of fans and feminists alike. With "Wonder Woman 3" slated for a 2023 release, look for another uptick in value for this classic comic.

SENSATION COMICS #1

Although this issue does not feature the first appearance of Wonder Woman, it is the most famous WW book around, as it presents the heroine's first cover appearance -an undeniably big moment in comics history. William Moulton Marston's revolutionary and cagily subversive heroine explodes onto the Golden Age comics scene, thereby officially establishing the "trinity" of DC's hero stable, and promoting a role model for millions of fans all over the world. The classic cover of this milestone issue displays H.G. Peter's trademark style, which combines the crude grace of ancient Greek art with the flowering majesty of storybook illustration.

AMAZING FANTASY #15



This is the Silver Age equivalent of Action Comics #1: a historic, game-changing key issue that acts as a pivot point from what came before, and what came after. The creation of Stan Lee and Steve Ditko, this radical new concept featured a passive, neurotic, everyman hero; an unusually emotionally charged origin story touching on issues of mortality and family tragedy; a worldview grounded solidly in a real, recognizable universe, obviously our own, and open-ended storytelling that rewarded close attention and regular readership. This milestone has also proven to be the success story of comics investment, growing rapidly and unstoppably in value and becoming one of the few completely bulletproof investments of recent times.

FANTASTIC FOUR #1

Inspired by DC's top-selling smorgasbord of heroes, the Justice League of America, Stan Lee and Jack Kirby went one better when creating a copycat title for Marvel. Instead of a mashup of existing heroes, Lee and Kirby struck upon the intriguing concept of creating a super-family, allowing young readers to instantly identify with the day-to-day squabbles and growing pains of the protagonists while still enjoying liberal doses of heroism. This dynamic and historic first issue hit the ground running with an action-packed cover and one of the most engrossing origin stories of the era. Silver Age Marvel keys are always in high demand and are consistently appreciating in value.

Overstreet Guide 2022 VG (4.0) value = \$11,000.

FANTASTIC FOUR #5

Dr. Doom, according to Jack Kirby, was modeled after the Middle Age concept of Death, hence the skull-like mask and hood. Kirby claimed that Doom is inherently evil, and as a result of his facial disfigurement and hatred for Reed Richards, he lashes out against the world in perpetual vengeance. Created by the team of Kirby and Stan Lee, the iconic character has been copied and imitated many times over the last fifty years, most notably as one of Lucasfilm's inspirations in creating Darth Vader. Doom is slated to debut in the MCU in the near future, making this book a very important target for investment collectors.

INCREDIBLE HULK #1



Inspired by Jekyll & Hyde and the Jewish myth of the Golem, Stan Lee and Jack Kirby kept their Silver Age hot streak running with the big and brutal Hulk. This issue preys on Cold War fears of nuclear annihilation and adolescent growing pains to create one of the most haunting and affecting of hero origins. Initially colored gray in his debut, the character was quickly reworked into a green goliath when the primitive four-color printing process mangled the original color scheme throughout the book, altering the powerful protagonist's hue from page to page. The famous cover image still resonates with fans to this day. With his recent guest appearance in "She-Hulk: Attorney at Law," the Hulk is once again a hot property with plenty of upside potential.

MARVEL COMICS #1



This is the beginning. Without this, there would be no Marvel Universe, no Captain America punching Hitler, no Marvel movies, no Spider-Man, not even today's superhero mythology as we know it. One of the top-five most important comics ever published, this haunting, moody, aggressively atmospheric issue took the simple, colorful genre pioneered by Shuster and Siegel and turned it into something vast and compelling. This issue features the first appearance of the Human Torch by Carl Burgos, the first Angel by Paul Gustavson, and the first appearance of the Sub-Mariner, by Bill Everett, whose deft illustrations instantly raised the bar for the new hero craze. This is likely the scarcest of major Golden Age keys, which never fails to ignite a frenzy of attention when copies come to market.





The first name in superheroes has always been Superman. "Look, up in the sky, it's a bird, it's a plane, it's...Superman!" Those words identified the character for decades and the big red "S" on his chest is one of the most-easily-recognized symbols in the world. Created by Jerry Siegel and Joe Shuster, Superman has enjoyed decades of popularity and has been featured in cartoons, serials, movies, television shows, and pretty much anything else you can put a price tag on. As one of the top Golden Age keys, this issue features Superman's origin story, a must-read for any serious comic collector. With the DCEU's "Man of Steel 2" currently in development, the price of this already extremely valuable grail book is poised to see another upwards trend.



THE QUENTIN EASTMAN COLLECTION

In 1984, Kevin Eastman and Peter Laird were two eager comic creators with big ambitions, working out of their home, dubbed "Mirage Studios," the pair planned to release a satiric comic about a quartet of turtles who use ninja weapons. Unfortunately, producing said comic would be costly. Kevin's uncle, Quentin Eastman, offered them a loan of \$1,000 to make their dreams come true.



With Quentin's help, the team released the first issue of Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles. The book was a success and quickly sold out its first printing, prompting Eastman and Laird to release reprints and additional issues. As time went on, Turtles fandom grew to such a fever pitch that the "Heroes in a Half-Shell" expanded into the wider cultural consciousness as a part of a successful television series, a toy line, video games, and feature films. For his part in bringing the series to life, Quentin was personally thanked in the first issue and was given copies of each comic produced by Mirage Studios as well as many pieces of early memorabilia. As big as the TMNT would become, the comic's creators always went above and beyond for the man they believed made it all possible.

Today, ComicConnect is proud to present the Quentin Eastman Collection. This assortment of rarities includes all of the key issues of the original Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles series, hand-made proof copies of the already incredibly rare two issues of Gobbledygook that predate the first TMNT issue, early promotional materials, graded action figures, art prints, and much more. Each item from this collection comes with a COA designed and signed by Quentin and adorned with his unique stamp.
